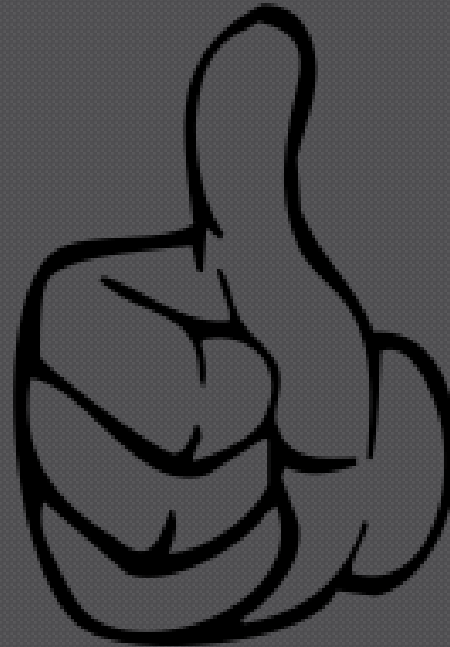

● Proof Of:

- Credibility
- Capability
- Feasibility
- Leverage
- Importance
- Sustainability

- ◉ Organizational Interview
- ◉ Content
 - Organizational Overview
 - Sustainability
 - Collaborations
 - Invite for Tour, if Applicable

Why Your Proposal May Be Denied

- ◉ Application is incomplete or not detailed enough for committee to make a decision
 - Evaluation plans are sketchy or absent.
 - Knowledge of best practices is not apparent.
 - Key questions are unanswered.
- ◉ Program is not eligible under grant guidelines or HCCF grantmaking policies
- ◉ Not enough funds to support all viable programs in this cycle

Receiving Funding

- ◉ Organizations who are accepted for funding will receive a grant acceptance letter outlining conditions of grant
- ◉ Required to submit a signed grant acceptance form that acknowledges you accept conditions of grant before funds are issued (60-day deadline or grant is forfeited)
- ◉ Grant checks will be cut once we receive signed acceptance form
- ◉ Grant Photo Moment

Grant Reports

- All Organizations awarded funding must submit a completed grant evaluation report at due date or at project completion, whichever comes first
 - July 31
 - December 31
- Photos & Impact Stories
- Organizations who do not comply are not eligible for future funding until report is received
